

FINANCE AND INFORMATION SYSTEMS

2014/15 – 2015/16 Operating Budget

The 2014/15 - 2015/16 Operating Budget was adopted by the City Council on June 24th. The City's Operating Budget establishes the funding allocations for all the services provided by the City including police, parks and recreation, street maintenance, water, sewer and garbage services. The total Operating Budget for fiscal year 2014/15 is \$184.5 million. The City's General Fund includes approximately \$44.7 million in both revenues and operating expenses and retains 30% of annual expenses in reserves. PUBLIC WORKS

Landscape Improvement Projects

Green Valley Landscape was awarded the Landscape Improvements project on June 10th by City Council. Work has begun and is anticipated to be complete by the end of this year.

- Brentwood Boulevard Median Landscape Improvements: Green Valley Landscape started the widening of Brentwood Boulevard from Homecoming Way to Hansen Lane. In addition to road widening at this location, this project will install roadway medians, landscaping improvements and a non-potable water line for irrigation purposes.



- Sand Creek Road Median: The two extended left turn lanes from eastbound Sand Creek Road into the Streets of Brentwood have been opened to traffic. Landscape improvements will commence once work on Brentwood Boulevard is complete.

Sand Creek Road Interchange

The second bridge over Sand Creek Road has been constructed. The contractor will next begin construction of the roadway approaches to the new bridge. It is expected that the bridge will be open to the public by late October. Once it is opened it will carry two northbound lanes over Sand Creek Road and eliminate the existing traffic shift to the westerly bridge.

Email/text alerts will send you an email and/or text message when something changes to your bus route(s). You can customize your settings to only receive information about the specific routes and services that you use.

Download Free Audiobooks on Tri Delta Transit Buses

How SnapNGo Works:

Step 1: Download a QR Code Reader application to your phone. Free download and QR Code information available at <https://snapngo.ccclib.org>

Step 2: Scan the SnapNGo QR barcode with your cell phone camera.

Step 3: Select a book to download and enjoy!
