Ground Water Production Well Site Painting

The City has begun its ground water production Well Site Painting CIP project. The City has nine well site locations that are being painted. This was completed approximately eight years ago. Painting the sites will improve overall facility condition and maintenance as it will help extend the life of piping and accessories. Additionally, the appearance of well-maintained facilities reflects positively during California Department of Public Health inspections.

Road Closure: State Highway 4

Caltrans will close State Route 4 (SR-4) from Tracy Boulevard to South Roberts Road beginning Friday, January 30, 2015, 8:00 p.m. until Monday, February 2, 2015, 4:00 a.m. Motorists can expect delays and should consider alternate routes.

Detours:

Eastbound

- Turn right heading southbound on Tracy Boulevard to Howard Road
- Turn left heading eastbound on Howard Road/Mathews Road
- Left on Roberts Road to eastbound SR-4 or continue straight on Howard Road/Mathews Road towards Interstate 5 (I-5)

Westbound

- Turn left heading southbound on Roberts Road
- Turn right heading westbound on Howard Road
- Turn right heading northbound on Tracy Boulevard
- Turn left onto westbound SR-4

Northbound or southbound on I-5 towards SR-4 West

- Exit 467B heading westbound towards Howard Road/Mathews Road
- Turn right heading northbound on Tracy Boulevard
- Turn left on to westbound SR-4
