Planning Commission

At its February 2 meeting, the Commission took the following actions:

- Recommended approval of a three-year time extension for St. James Court, an eight-lot tentative subdivision map located at 1060 Minnesota Avenue. The recommendation will be forwarded to the City Council on February 23 for final action.
- Approved a two-year time extension for Brentwood Country Club, a 63-lot tentative subdivision map and corresponding design review located south of Balfour Road between State Route 4 and Summerset Drive.

The Commission also received two informational reports. The first was from staff and the Brentwood Union School District regarding the District’s master plan and needs analysis. The second report was from staff on some of the unique challenges associated with medium density housing projects and their relationship to the City’s Residential Design Guidelines. Examples of these challenges include working with projects that have smaller than normal lot sizes and the ripple effect they create in providing adequate building setbacks, sufficient architectural diversity among and between homes, single-story profile homes, and more flexible lot coverage requirements.

Water Conservation - Rebates Ending

On January 26, 2016, City Council approved the elimination of water conservation usage rebates. The Ordinance to remove usage rebates takes effect February 25, 2016. This means that water used through February 25 is eligible for a rebate. Customers are encouraged to keep saving and can help by turning off sprinklers and fixing leaks.

Funds are still available for the Convert for Cash Rebate Program for customers who want to replace their lawns with drought friendly alternatives, or purchase high efficiency toilets or washing machines.
