


Join the City of Brentwood this October for

Scarecrows in the Park

Here's how it works...

- Design and build your own Scarecrow. Scarecrows will be displayed in City Park beginning October 17
- Sign up with the Parks and Recreation Department. Class #16230. Fee: \$16 per scarecrow.
- Registration deadline: 5PM, Friday, October 14
- Ribbons awarded in two categories:
Non-Professional or Design Professional.

GUIDELINES & ENTRY RULES:

Anyone can register! Families, community groups, small businesses, and individuals are all welcome to participate.

If you have anyone on your scarecrow team that is in any way compensated for art or design services (e.g. graphic, landscape, or floral design; or architect or artist; or anything similar), you must register in the Design Professional category.

The Non-Professional category is for everyone else.

All bases must be capable of supporting the scarecrow in a freestanding/staked or seated manner.

The City reserves the right to remove any scarecrow that deteriorates to an unacceptable level during the week.

Please make your submissions as weather-proof and indestructible as possible!

The City is not responsible for loss or damage to scarecrows while on display.

The City will provide signage identifying your organization and the name of your scarecrow. The City will determine the location of all scarecrows.

If you are considering building a scarecrow larger than a refrigerator, please let the City know.

Please do not include live plant material or mulch with your display.

The City reserves the right to use photographs, contact names, and scarecrow names for publicity purposes. City reserves the right to dispose of any scarecrows not retrieved by their owners by 5pm Friday, October 28th.

Entries must be suitable for viewing by small children. Entries reflecting controversial political or social subject matter, in poor taste for family viewing (i.e. very scary/gory), or overtly commercial or promotional in nature will not be allowed.

Judging will take place on or before October 21st. Winners will be announced prior to the start of the movie on Friday, October 21st in City Park.

Ribbon awards for 1st - 3rd place in each category with a photo of the first place winner in each category placed in the Winter/Spring 2017 Activities Guide.
