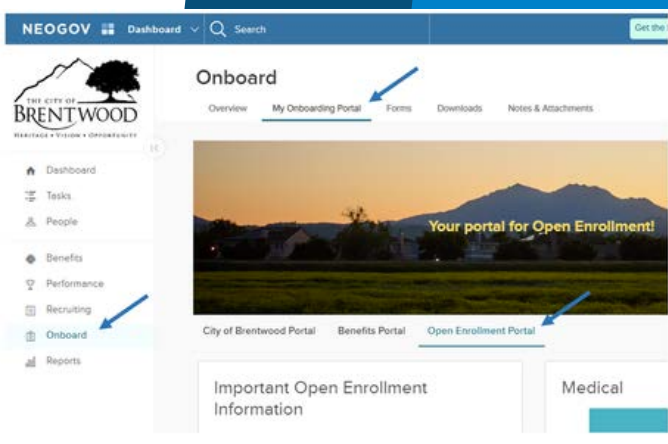

What You Need to Know About Your PERS Gold and PERS Platinum Plans

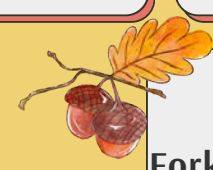
