Frequently Asked Questions:

Are a business license and a Business Tax Certificate the same thing?

Yes. The terms business license and Business Tax Certificate are interchangeable.

Do I need a Business Tax Certificate for a home based business?

Yes, a Business Tax Certificate is required. If you're operating (or plan to operate) a business from your home in Brentwood, please print and complete the [Home Occupation Zoning Review Application \(HOZR\)](#). The City encourages zoning review prior to obtaining a Business Tax Certificate. The HOZR Application is submitted to Community Development Department, inside the Permit Center at City Hall. Reference Municipal Code 17.840.

I have a rental property in Brentwood; do I need to obtain a Business Tax Certificate?

Yes. "Business" means and includes professions, trades, vocations, rentals, leases, enterprises, establishments, and occupations. The [Business Tax Certificate Application – Rental](#) will need to be completed and submitted. The "Gross Receipts" (application line #30) is the amount of rent the landlord anticipates collecting in the upcoming year. The "Business Location" (application line #2) is the address of the rental property. Municipal Code section 5.04.040.

Will I need a fictitious business name?

If any name is used other than your personal proper name, you must register the business name with the County Clerk Recorder to get a Fictitious Business Name Statement. Residential landlords will use their first and last name as the name of the business, if they do not have a fictitious name. For more information on fictitious business name, contact the Contra Costa County Clerk's office at (925)335-7900.

What are Gross Receipts? (Line #30 of the Business Tax Certificate application)

Gross receipts are the total amount received from all sources relating to business conducted within City of Brentwood. For businesses with headquarters located outside the City of Brentwood, total gross receipts shall be deemed to be related to business conducted within city limits, unless an apportionment of gross receipts is requested by the business pursuant to Municipal Code section 5.04.040 F.

What is the State Mandated Fee? (Line #34 of the Business Tax Certificate application)

Assembly Bill 783, Single-User Restrooms

Effective January 1, 2024, Assembly Bill 783 (AB783), Single-User Restrooms, requires Cities that issue Business Tax Certificates (BTC's) to provide written notices of AB783 requirements during the issuance of a new or renewal BTC. AB783 requires that toilet facilities that are defined as "single-user toilet facility", per California Health and Safety Code Section 118600, shall be identified as all-gender toilet facilities and will be designated for use by no more than one occupant at a time, for family use or assisted use by signage that complies with Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations.

Senate Bill 1186, License Fee and Use for Construction-Related Accessibility

On September 19, 2012, Governor Brown signed into law Senate Bill 1186 (SB1186), which added a state mandated fee of \$1 on all applicants, newly issued and renewed business licenses. AB1379 was signed, extending SB1186 and increasing the fee to \$4, January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2023. AB2164 was signed, extending SB1186 fee of \$4 indefinitely.
