

TENANT IMPROVEMENT REMODEL/ALTERATION Submittal Requirements

Neighborhood Services

A permit application is to be submitted along with (three (3) sets) of plans drawn to scale:

- ☐ Plans must be drawn to scale on minimum 11"x17", maximum 24"x36" paper.
- ☐ Plans must be signed by the Design Professional (if structural or occupancy changes, a Licensed Architect or Engineer must prepare plans). The plans shall include the following:

> Cover page (which must include):

- Project name (ex: Bob's Restaurant)
- Signature of Designer(s)
- Contact information for Designer(s)
- Occupancy classification (A,B,M etc.)
- The type of building construction (Type I,II,V etc.)
- Square footage of project
- The number of stories
- Height of building
- Occupant load
- State the current code cycle (currently 2022 Cal Codes) and list all applicable codes
- A page index
- Whether the space is fire sprinklered
- The legal description of the building (Assessor's Parcel Number)
- The site address
- Contact information for all Designers whose plans are included in the submittal (Electrical Engineer, Mechanical Engineer, etc.)
- Detailed scope of work
- · List of deferred submittal items
- Applicable flood plain information

Site plan

Show accessible features including all paths of travel, parking, and entrance components.

> Existing floor plan

Proposed floor plan (showing):

- New, relocated, and/or deleted walls, doors, etc. with framing and bracing details.
- Doors and other opening dimensions.
- Accessible path of travel from area of work to exit discharge and to public way, if applicable.
- Egress pathways including length of travel, width of egress pathway, etc.
- Indicate any required occupancy or fire separation walls, or corridors.

Electrical Plan (including):

- Receptacle outlet locations and light fixture location.
- Location of switches for lighting control.
- A panel schedule with electrical load calculations.
- Location of lighting control panel.

Plumbing Plan (including):

- Location and type of new fixtures.
- Water heater location (if above the ceiling, a permanent ladder is required) and fuel type.
- Restaurants, automobile repair, car wash, laundries, etc., please provide size, type and location of interceptors along with sizing calculations.
- One line schematic drawings for all new piping.
- A slab dowel detail if cutting/removing slab floor.

Mechanical plan system changes or additions (including):

- HVAC units, location, ducts, diffusers, etc., provide duct sizing.
- Thermostat location and type (e.g., setback) information.
- Any make up, ventilation, or exhaust air requirements.
- > Title 24 Energy documentation for lighting, mechanical, and envelope changes (2 sets)
- > Cal Green (Include all mandatory measures)

The codes that should be referenced on the title-sheet of drawings as governing the design of the tenant improvement are the:

- 2022 California Building Code (CBC)
- 2022 California Plumbing Code (CPC)
- 2022 California Mechanical Code (CMC)
- 2022 California Electrical Code (CEC)
- 2022 California Energy Code (Title 24)
- 2022 California Green Building Standards Code
- 2022 California Fire Code
- Brentwood Municipal Code
