

Your business is considered a "Home Occupation" if it meets the following regulations (per Section 17.840 of the Brentwood Municipal Code). If your business cannot meet one or more of these regulations, please contact the Planning Department at (925) 516-5405 to obtain information regarding the appropriate zoning approval process. In addition, business owners are required to apply for and obtain a business license.

Please check each box and sign and date below to indicate that you understand and will comply with the following regulations: No clients or customers shall visit the premises in connection with the home business. An exception is allowed for teaching, counseling, or instructional activities only per Section 17.840.009 of the Municipal Code. Please indicate below if an exception is being pursued in relation to one of these activities. No Yes (subject to review and approval by the CD Director or the Planning Commission) The home business shall consist of activities related to office use (including but not limited to computer, telephone, bookkeeping, and drafting uses) only. The home business shall be conducted in no more than one room or 20% of the home, if conducted within a garage the doors shall remain closed at all times and shall be clearly incidental and subordinate to the use of the structure as a residence. ☐ No commercial vehicle shall be stored on the site in excess of a one-ton vehicle registered to the owner of the home. No commercial retail sales shall be permitted on-site. ☐ There shall be no signs displayed or posted on the premises in conjunction with the home business. The residence address shall not be used in any advertising done in conjunction with the home business. There shall be no external evidence of the home business and it will not change the residential character of the dwelling. The home occupation shall not create pedestrian or vehicular traffic in excess of the amount normally generated by residential uses allowed in the district. Only persons residing at the home may be employed within the home by the business. A complete list of prohibited uses and activities are available at the Community Development Department. Your business is considered a "Home Occupation for Cottage Food" if it meets the following regulations (per Section 17.840.010 of the Brentwood Municipal Code). Please complete this form and submit it to the Planning Department. If your business cannot meet one or more of these regulations, please contact the Planning Department at (925) 516-5405 to obtain information regarding the appropriate zoning approval process. In addition, business owners are required to apply for and obtain a business license.

eck each box and sign and date below to indicate that you understand and will comply with the egulations:
Only one vehicle and two customers shall visit the premises with a maximum of twelve customers per day limited to the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday. Sunday hours and outdoor sales are prohibited.
If employees or customers will be coming to the home, the home must meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) access requirements.
No on-site dining related to the Cottage Food business shall occur on the site.
No more than one full-time equivalent employee, not including the operator's family or household members, shall be on the premises at any time.
Trash collection and recycling is limited to regular 64 gallon cart service. No commercial trash collection shall occur on the site.
There shall be no discharge of grease associated with the cottage food operation into the City's solid waste system.
Parking for the business shall be accommodated in the designated parking spaces for the home or apartment including the property's garage or carport and driveway. On-site parking for apartment complexes or other multi-family residences, if applicable, must receive and attach written approval from the property owner, landlord, homeowners association or property manager.
On-street parking spaces may be used only for persons picking-up and/or delivering materials for the operation and third party retailers coming to the property.
On-site loading of food products into vehicles shall occur within an enclosed garage with the garage door shut, or outside of the garage with limited hours from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday. No outdoor loading shall occur on Sundays. Vehicles shall not idle when being loaded.
Delivery vehicles over one ton shall not park on the site, and no delivery vehicles over 10,000 pounds shall visit the site.
There shall be no signs displayed or posted on the premises in conjunction with the home business.

	Will obtain all necessary approvals from the Contra Costa County Environmental Health division as required for cottage food businesses.
	Will prepare and/or package cottage food products that are not potentially hazardous foods and are permitted foods by the Contra Costa County Environmental Health division, in accordance with the California Health and Safety Code.
	There shall be no external evidence of the home business and it will not change the residential character of the dwelling.
	The residence address shall not be used in any advertising done in conjunction with the home business.
