A-Frame Sign Requirements

- One free standing A-frame sign per business.
- Must be at the site business is located.
- Only be on display when the business is open.
- Shall not obstruct pedestrian right of way or visibility.
- Maximum sign size is 10 square feet or less.
- Maximum sign height is 4 feet above the adjacent grade.
- Must be portable and not affixed to City right-of-way, or damage landscaping.
- Shall not be illuminated, use lights, flags, balloons, streamers, blinking or reflecting devices.

Outdoor Dining and Displays

- The City of Brentwood encourages outdoor dining and outdoor displays, the process is quick and easy.
 - ✓ Obtain an Administrative Design Review from the City's Planning Department at (925) 516-5405.
 - ✓ Obtain an Encroachment Permit from the City's Engineering Department (925) 516-5420. The application is available online at the City's web site (www.brentwoodca.gov) under the 'How Do I" tab.

Banner Sign Requirements

- Require a Temporary Sign Permit.
- Only one banner at a time, per establishment.
- Must be at the site business is located.
- Shall not be mounted on or project into the public right-of-way.
- Shall only be displayed for a maximum of four time periods each calendar year. A period not running more than 30 consecutive days, with a break of at least 60 days before a banner is displayed again.
- Banners shall not exceed 50 square feet or 10% of building face, whichever is less.
- Banners shall not be illuminated.
- Banners shall be securely fastened on all sides to a permanent on-site structure such as a building, fence or wall.
- Banners shall be constructed of durable and weatherproof materials such as vinyl or woven nylon and shall be continuously maintained in good condition.
- Banner permit applications are available on the City's web site (www.brentwoodca.gov), under the Planning page.
