Get Your Flu Vaccination Today!



Everyone 6 months of age and older should get a flu vaccine every season, with rare exception. Vaccination is particularly important for people who are at high risk of serious complications from influenza. You should get a flu vaccine before flu viruses begin spreading in your community, since it takes about two weeks after vaccination for antibodies to develop in the body and provide protection against flu. A flu vaccination has important benefits such as reducing flu illnesses, doctors' visits, missed work and flu-related hospitalizations.
