◆ March – November

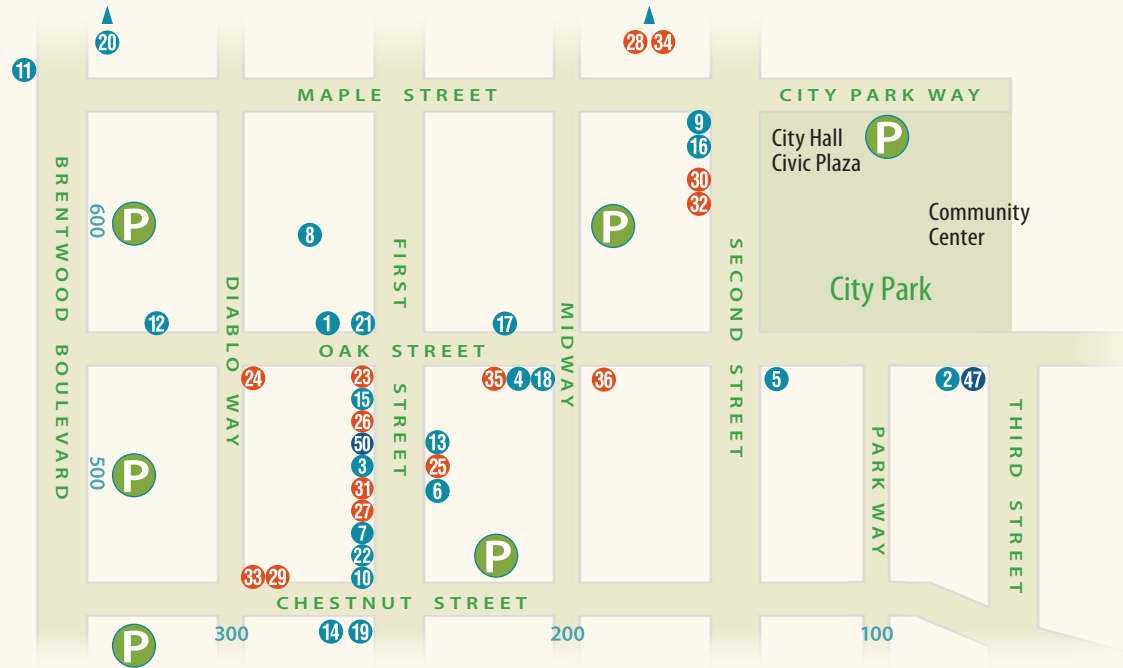
