

Well, we finally made it through 2022, truly a year of change, heartbreak, and also new opportunities. Your Senior Center reopened to an ever-successful series of programs, classes, warm meals, and good fellowship. Membership in the Senior Club continued to grow and now tops 825 (don't forget to renew your dues for 2023!), and ballots will soon be in the mail asking you to vote for the 2023-2024 Board leadership team.

A new year also brings the time when your Board begins its review of the club's programs and services. We hope you will be a part of this effort and let your voice and thoughts be heard. Last year the Board began an outreach effort by calling members to learn more about them and their interests. We found that many members have moved to Brentwood from other communities with senior programs and thus have knowledge and experiences that can benefit our Club. Recently, I noticed an article in the newspaper about the issue of people living by themselves. The article noted that in 1960, the year I graduated from high school, just 13% of the households were single occupancy. Today that has increased to 30%, with an even higher 36% of people over 50 years of age living alone, or over 50 million Americans. The article suggests that while many 50 and 60 year olds thrive living solo, the research unequivocally shows that single people face worse physical and mental health outcomes as they age and shorter life spans.

This is where the Senior Club comes in. We have a passion for supporting our members. In analyzing our Club, we find nearly 75% of our membership is female and many are living solo. If you're one of these single folks, we hope you will join our single mingle social program and read this newsletter

to find other activities to join in. If you have an program interest or idea, let us know and let's see if together we can come up with something new to add to our programs.

IN Memoriam • GERTRUDE DELORIS "DEEDEE" CORNELL

August 14, 1943~November 7, 2022



DeeDee grew up in Clarksburg, West Virginia, moving to the Bay Area in 1971. She loved going into San Francisco for music concerts and dancing every Saturday night. During her visits to the big city, DeeDee shook hands with Elvis Presley and Jerry Lewis. How exciting it must have been for her! In her later

years she lived in Byron with husband Tippy. DeeDee's niece shared that she loved her fiends at the Senior Center and doing crafts. She always had a smile or a hug to give. She loved her little Byron United Methodist church. She referenced them as "her church family." We always remember DeeDee saying, "I am never too full for ice cream."

Scholarships Update

The Scholarship Program is once again available beginning January 2023, for qualifying club members that wish to participate in the Senior Citizens Club programs, (trips, classes, and special events.)

The Senior Scholarship Committee will award \$150.00 scholarships from January 1st through December 31st, 2023 to approved applicants until funds are no longer available. Scholarships can be used to subsidize 100% of the cost of qualifying programs/activities. The Scholarship is good until your awarded funds run out. You may re-apply for a Scholarship as long as your membership dues remain current.


Scholarship Application forms will be available at the Brentwood Senior Activity Center during regular business hours. When you have completed the application, you may drop it off at the front desk of the BSAC, or mail it to the P.O. Box address at the bottom of the application.

When received, your application will be forwarded to the Scholarship Committee for review. Once reviewed, the Committee will notify you by phone or letter of their decision. Please keep your club membership dues up to date, otherwise your application will be denied and you will need to reapply.

She is a long time resident in our community. Her roots have been in Brentwood and surrounding communities for quite some time. Stacey has been self-employed for 25 years. During that time, she has helped her husband with their charter business. She definitely has a passion to help other organizations and non-profits. She brings knowledge of business and fundraising experiences for non-profits. Stacey says, "I am doing this for Mom who was a previous vendor at the Senior Club event. Mom told me, 'I miss the Craft Faire and being a vendor. Can you help with the Craft Faire?' How can I say no to Mom?"

If you would like to be a vendor at the 2023 Art & Craft Faire and sell your hand-crafted items, please fill out the application on page 13. Application and fees are due by April 21, 2023. Please submit pictures of your products with your application. Turn in applications at the Senior Activity Center or mail to Stacey Mullins, P.O. Box 458, Knightsen, CA 94548.

All applications will be reviewed by the Craft Faire Committee comprised of at least three people. Space is limited. Not all vendors will be selected. If not selected, you will be fully reimbursed for your application fees. Vendor selection will be completed by Friday, June 2, 2023. Vendors will be notified by July 7, 2023. Once selected, there will be no cancellation refunds.

The Faire runs November 3-5, 2023: Friday 5:00–7:30 • Saturday 10:00–4:00 • Sunday 11:00–3:00 Displays must be set up before the event's scheduled start time and may not be disassembled prior to ending. Each vendor is provided a 6 foot table. Your display may not exceed the designated space. Parking provisions, set- up information and any show details will be mailed to you upon acceptance.
