## Response Times

CALLS FOR SERVICE ARE PRIORITIZED INTO TWO GENERAL CATEGORIES:

- <u>PRIORITY 1</u> CALLS FOR SERVICE INVOLVING AN IMMEDIATE THREAT TO LIFE OR CRIMES THAT ARE IN PROGRESS.
- PRIORITY 2 CALLS FOR SERVICE THAT ARE A HIGH PRIORITY BUT DO NOT ELEVATE TO THE LEVEL OF AN EMERGENCY.

#### Definitions

■ AGGRAVATED ASSAULT — WHEN A BATTERY IS COMMITTED AGAINST ANY PERSON AND SERIOUS BODILY INJURY IS INFLICTED ON THE PERSON, OR A DEADLY WEAPON IS USED.

■ SIMPLE ASSAULT — WHEN A BATTERY IS COMMITTED AGAINST ANY PERSON THAT DOES NOT AMOUNT TO SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, AND A DEADLY WEAPON IS NOT USED.



#### **ENGAGE SURVEY RESULTS**

- ALL RESULTS ARE FROM DECEMBER 1, 2022 MARCH 15, 2023
- 92% of Respondents were satisfied with the professionalism of the dispatcher.
- 92% OF RESPONDENTS WERE SATISFIED WITH THE PROFESSIONALISM OF THE OFFICER THEY INTERACTED WITH.
- 91% of Respondents were satisfied with the response time to their call.
- 89% OF RESPONDENTS WERE SATISFIED WITH THEIR OVERALL EXPERIENCES WITH THE BRENTWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT.
- 23.6% OVERALL RESPONSE TO THE SURVEYS SENT OUT.
