TWO GENERAL CATEGORIES:

## PRIORITY 1 –

CALLS FOR SERVICE INVOLVING AN IMMEDIATE THREAT TO LIFE OR  
CRIMES THAT ARE IN PROGRESS.

## PRIORITY 2 –

CALLS FOR SERVICE THAT ARE A HIGH PRIORITY BUT DO NOT ELEVATE  
TO THE LEVEL OF AN EMERGENCY.

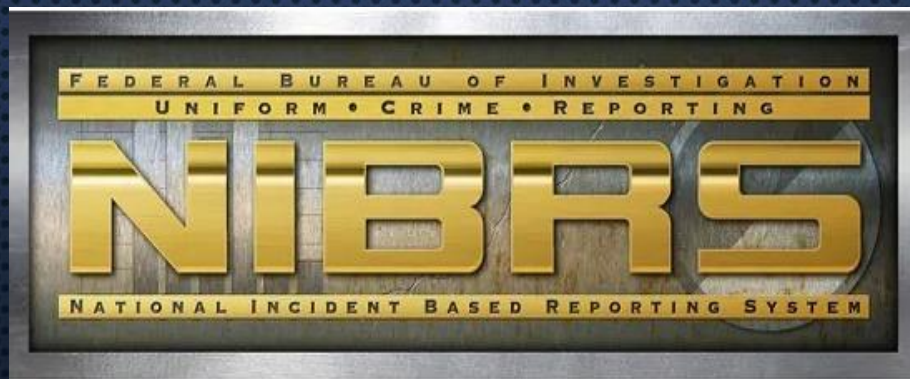

# INCIDENTS OF CRIME

- **NIBRS ELIMINATED THE HIERARCHY RULE WHICH UCR UTILIZED TO COLLECT DATA ON THE MOST SERIOUS OFFENSE PER INCIDENT AND CATEGORIZED THEM AS PART 1, VIOLENT CRIMES AND PART 2, PROPERTY CRIMES**
- **NIBRS REPORTS EVERY OFFENSE PROVIDED THE OFFENSES ARE SEPARATE AND DISTINCT CRIMES AND EACH ARE MUTUALLY EXCLUSIVE CRIMES AND CATEGORIZES THEM INTO GROUP A AND GROUP B OFFENSES**
- **BOTH UCR AND NIBRS COLLECT DATA ON HOMICIDE, RAPE, ROBBERY, AGGRAVATED ASSAULT, BURGLARY, MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT, LARCENY-THEFT AND ARSON. THEY ALSO BOTH COLLECT DATA ON “CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS” AND “CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY”**

# CURRENT STAFFING LEVELS

72 SWORN POSITIONS – 66 POSITIONS FILLED

23 SWORN ASSIGNED TO NON - PATROL  
FUNCTIONS

49 SWORN ASSIGNED TO PATROL

- 8 SERGEANTS
  - 5 ACTUALLY WORKING
- 41 OFFICERS
  - 27 ACTUALLY WORKING



# CURRENT STAFFING LEVELS

## CURRENT AVERAGE:

5 OFFICERS & 1 SERGEANT PER SHIFT

## TO IMPLEMENT THE 5<sup>TH</sup> BEAT WE NEED A MINIMUM OF:

6 OFFICERS & 1 SERGEANT PER SHIFT



# ENGAGE SURVEY RESULTS 2023

- **BRENTWOOD PD SENT OUT 50,534 SURVEYS. 23% WERE COMPLETED**
- **92% OF RESPONDENTS WERE SATISFIED WITH THE PROFESSIONALISM OF THE DISPATCHER**
- **94% OF RESPONDENTS WERE SATISFIED WITH THE PROFESSIONALISM OF THE OFFICER THEY INTERACTED WITH**

# ENGAGE SURVEY RESULTS 2023

- **92% OF RESPONDENTS WERE SATISFIED WITH THE RESPONSE TIME TO THEIR CALL**
- **89% OF RESPONDENTS WERE SATISFIED WITH THEIR OVERALL EXPERIENCE WITH THE BRENTWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT**
- **80% OVERALL FEEL SAFE LIVING/BEING IN THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD**
