General Information

Full payment is due at time of enrollment by cash, check, or Visa/MasterCard/Discover/American Express. Checks are payable to the City of Brentwood. Returned checks will be assessed a service charge of \$19.35.



Participants must pre-register for all programs unless otherwise noted. It is the participant's responsibility to attend the activity or call to verify their enrollment if a receipt is not received. Some programs and sports have different registration dates. These separate registrations will be listed in the guide.

Refund Policy

Our department strives to provide you with high quality programs. Some situations that occur are beyond our control. Withdrawals/refunds could cause the class/activity/program to drop below the minimum required attendance, which could cause the class/activity/program to be cancelled. City reserves the right to cancel a program and refund under extenuating circumstances. Should you be dissatisfied, please contact us and staff will work with you to the best of our ability.

- Refunds will be considered upon request to the Parks & Recreation Department.
- Refund requests made no later than halfway through a class/activity/session may be subject to a partial refund. If applicable, a uniform fee will be deducted from the refund.
- Refund requests made after the last class/activity/session will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- Refunds are processed within 30 days.
- Refund policies may vary for Adult Leagues, Aquatics, Senior Trips and Facility Permits.

Cancellations

Classes without minimum enrollment will be cancelled or combined. If the activity, class, or trip is cancelled the City will issue a refund, or credit your account. Class/Program schedules, fees, instructors, policies and procedures are subject to change without notice.
